



## AVERY FLYNN

Romantic suspense novelist Avery Flynn, author of **A DRY CREEK BED** and **UP A DRY CREEK**, has no misconceptions about the glamorous lives of writers, but that doesn't mean she misses any of the fun associated with being published and sharing her work with readers. When she's not toiling away at her desk behind the "bookshelf dividing my office from the rest of the kitchen," she's chatting with readers via her blog, Facebook and Twitter, keeping abreast of what they're reading and what they like.

**UP A DRY CREEK**, her first novel, began her *Dry Creek* series set in Nebraska. Avery, who grew up in a small town in the western part of the state, recalls that "when I graduated high school I couldn't cross the state line fast enough." Now living life at high speed just outside of Washington, D.C. she says "the older I got and the farther I moved away, the more I realized what a wonderful place Nebraska had been to live. I swore I'd set a novel here as a way to give people a look into the amazing folks that live in my home state."

Avery returns to Dry Creek for **A DRY CREEK BED**, which brings back Claire Layton and Jake Warwick from her first novel, along with Claire's brothers Hank, Chris and Sam, for the story of Hank and Beth Martinez. Beth, who has seen her share of tragedy and has already had her dream of her own family ripped away from her, is being strong armed into selling her grandparent's home. When the coercion becomes dangerous she turns to Hank, and together they set out to uncover who wants the land and why—before they both end up dead



The name Avery Flynn is a pseudonym for the author who, at least for now, prefers to remain behind the scenes. She believes having Avery as her alter ego is a very good thing because, as she says, "Pen name Avery is way cooler than me. Her favorite color is hot pink. Author Avery has been writing since she was a child and her father gave her a baby blue Brother typewriter. Today, Avery maintains a blog, where she talks about her life and books, muses on subjects as diverse as head lice and recommended books, shares video that tickles her fancy such as the "Movie and Television Kiss Montage" from You Tube, proposes "sound tracks" for her novels, and features authors such as Janet Evanovich, Lori Foster and Sarah Wendell.

She continues to write and work at her day job while enjoying her own happily ever after with her dashing husband, three crazy kids and two arthritic dogs. She dreams of one day having a floor-to-ceiling library à la *Beauty and the Beast* and is working to perfect the coffee IV drip. For right now, however, she's delighted to have her first two books published, and to be hard at work on Sam's story in **HIGH AND DRY CREEK**, her third *Dry Creek* novel.
